How to Help: 3 Steps!

Step 1: Check the Internet for local family shelters, soup kitchens, food pantries, nonprofit childcare centers, Early Head Start programs, etc.

Step 2: Find out what your local program needs to help babies. Organize a collection. Items may include:

- Diapers (all sizes)
- Formula and baby food
- Baby hygiene items
- Strollers and car seats

Step 3: Beyond providing these essential items, you might be able to help in other ways. HEAR US suggests:

- Show and share the Yay Babies! and other HEAR US videos.
- Volunteer at a local program on a regular basis to help families with small babies.
- Advocate for improved services and affordable housing for families.
- Host a gathering to share information and show the short HEAR US video, Littlest Nomads, about homeless babies/toddlers.
- Use your network! Invite schools, scout troops, civic organizations, faith communities, etc. to support your local programs that help homeless families.
